Smooth Transition from Kindergarten to Primary One

Moving from kindergarten to primary school is a very big challenge for young children. They need to have someone to help them adjust and adapt to the new school life. LCU provides Summer Chinese Bridging Programme to P.1 students and parents to get them ready for primary school. Parents can also join our Orientation Day with their children in August to better understand what students learn in class. Transition Programme with various meaningful activities in September helps P.1 students to make friends and get them familiar with the school routine. Students are taken good care of by the dual class teachers and big brothers and sisters throughout the year.

To help students learn with ease and enjoyment, there are no dictations, tests or examinations for P.1 students. Different modes of formative assessments are carried out from time to time for parents and teachers to have a clearer picture of their learning progress.

Innovation-led Curriculum

To equip our students to cope with challenges in the 21st century, meaningful learning activities are designed to deepen their understanding in different subjects, develop their critical thinking and innovation, and apply the knowledge they have gained across different disciplines. Our lessons are facilitated with Google Classroom which makes learning more productive, collaborative, and meaningful. Students of all levels have access to a wide range of technology devices, including desktop computers, iPads, Apple Pencils, VR learning kits, drones, 3D scanner and printer, micro:bit, Lego robots and Marty robots, etc. Our students also undertake coding and basic AI courses during IT lessons to learn about computational thinking, using mathematics and logic to solve problems. Classrooms at LCU are fun, pleasant and vibrant places of learning where creativity is encouraged.

Apart from core subjects, our school offers after-school language elective classes for students to extend their language abilities.
