Dear Parents / Guardians,

### **Arrangements of Early Commencement of Summer Holiday**

In view of the exponential growth of local confirmed cases of COVID-19, the Education Bureau (EDB) announced that all schools will start the summer holiday on 13 July, 2020.

#### **Opening of School Campus**

1. From 13 July 2020 (Monday) to 22 July 2020 (Wednesday), we will arrange staff to be on duty from 8:00 am to 1:15 pm, Monday to Friday, to look after students who need to come back to school for lack of carer at home.
2. For the safety of the students, if parents have to send your child/ ward to school, please call the school to let us know in advance. Since the school bus service is suspended, parents need to bring the students to school and pick them up from school on time. Moreover, students are requested to have their temperature checked before they come, wear a surgical mask and come to school according to the normal school hours in uniform.

#### **Summer Reading Programme**

1. The EDB launches the “Gift Book Pilot Scheme (2020)” to offer free printed books to all primary students with an aim to encourage leisure reading anytime and anywhere during the summer holiday and nurture students’ good reading habits. Each P1 or P.6 student will receive one book. For P.2-5, each student will receive two books. Because of the early commencement of summer holiday, all books will be distributed to students in September after the summer vacation.
2. Our school has also joined “eRead Scheme” organized by Hong Kong Education City. The scheme provides a wide range of quality Chinese and English e-books in various categories and levels. There are 100 Chinese and 150 English free ebooks available from 16 July to 31 December 2020 with unlimited access. Students can download the EdBookShelf mobile app, or go to the “eRead Scheme” website (<https://www.hkedcity.net/ereadscheme>) via a web browser, and log in with their HKEdCity accounts to enjoy reading.

#### **Purchase of Textbooks (2020/21 School Year)**

1. The selling of textbooks for the new school year by our textbook supplier, T. H. Lee Book Co. Ltd., is rescheduled to 4 September 2020 (Friday). Parents can also choose to buy the textbooks from other bookshops.

2. In order to avoid gathering due to COVID-19, textbooks will be sent into the classroom directly and the supplier will not sell textbooks to parents on that day. Students must submit the 7-11 payment slip and receipt to their class teacher on 1 September if they want to purchase textbooks through the school.

### **Preparation for Secondary School for Primary 6 Students**

1. P.6 students should follow the instructions given by the allocated secondary school regarding the arrangement of Pre-Secondary One Hong Kong Attainment Test (if any).
2. P.6 students should check the school website of the secondary school for any related information.

### **Strengthening preventive measures and following health advice by the Centre for Health Protection**

1. Parents should avoid letting their children go to crowded places.
2. Wear a surgical mask when taking public transport or staying in crowded places. It is important to wear a mask properly, including hand hygiene before wearing and after removing a mask.
3. Wash hands with liquid soap and water, especially before touching the mouth, nose or eyes, after touching public installation or when hands are contaminated by respiratory secretion after coughing and sneezing.
4. If any students are confirmed to have infected by COVID-19 or have had “intimate physical contact” with suspected/confirmed person infected by COVID-19, parents should report to the school as soon as possible so that the school can take appropriate measure and report the case to the Central Notification Office of the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) immediately.
