Introduction of Cheungdu

- □ Chengdu(成都), also known as Rong (蓉), Rongcheng (蓉城), and Jincheng (锦城), is the capital city of Sichuan Province and a megacity under the jurisdiction of the province.
- Located in southwest China, in the western Sichuan Basin and on the eastern edge of the Qinghai-Tibet Plateau, it spans a total area of 14,335 square kilometres. Southwestern Mandarin is the official language.



Sanxingdui Museum

◆ The Sanxingdui Museum Park is located in the northeast corner of the Sanxingdui Ruins, covering an area of about 1,000 acres. It is famous both at home and abroad for its four major features: cultural relics, architecture, displays, and gardens. It is one of the first national first-class museums.



Kuanzhai Alley



◆ Kuanzhai Alley, also known as "Wide and Narrow Alley" or "Kuanzhaixiangzi Alley", consists of three historic parallel alleys from the Qing dynasty. Ancientstyle buildings, local Chengdu life, delicious Sichuan snacks, exquisite Sichuan handicrafts, etc. make it one of the most attractive places in Chengdu.

Sichuan University Affiliated Experimental Primary School

◆ Sichuan University Affiliated **Experimental Primary School** was founded in 1908 and is located on the campus of Sichuan University. It currently has multiple campuses, including the main campus, the West Campus, and the Dongshan International Campus. It became a sister school with LCU in January 2025.



Sichuan University Museum



- ◆ Sichuan University Museum is the earliest museum established in Southwest China. It was planned and built in 1914.
- ♦ It is now a national first-class museum with more than 80,000 historical and cultural relics, and its collection of animal and plant specimens is also among the best in domestic universities.

Sichuan Museum

◆ The Sichuan Museum is the largest comprehensive museum in Southwest China. Founded in 1941, it formerly served as the National Sichuan Museum.

 ◆ It currently houses over 350,000 cultural relics, including over 70,000 precious items.



Chengdu Art Museum



- ◆ Tianfu Art Museum is located in Chengdu's Tianfu Art Park. It covers a total area of nearly 40,000 square meters, with nearly 13,000 square meters of exhibition space and 13 specialized exhibition halls.
- ◆ The building, shaped like a hibiscus flower, is positioned as a large, comprehensive urban art museum.

Panda Valley

- ◆ Panda Valley, also known as the Dujiangyan Breeding and Reintroduction Research Center of the Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding, opened in 2015.
- ◆ It houses giant pandas for rewilding and reintroduction, and features supporting facilities such as giant panda enclosures and a red panda ecological release area.



Dujiangyan Irrigation System



- ◆ It was built in 256 BC by Li Bing, the prefect of Shu County in the Qin State. It is 56 kilometres away from Chengdu.
- ◆ With a history of more than two thousand years, the Dujiangyan Irrigation System is the only preserved non-control irrigation system which is still in use. This system is the only reason why Chengdu is called the "Land of Abundance".

Guanxian Ancient City

◆ Guanxian Ancient City is located in the core urban area of Dujiangyan City, Sichuan Province. It dates back to the Northern and Southern Dynasties period (1468-1526). It is named for its location at the Baopingkou Canal in the Dujiangyan Irrigation Project, earning it the nickname "The First Town at the Source of Heavenly Abundance."



Nan Qiao



- Nanqiao, located on the Minjiang River below Baopingkou in Dujiangyan, Sichuan Province, is a prominent landmark in Guanxian Ancient City. The bridge is approximately 54 meters long and 12 meters wide.
- ◆ Combining practicality and artistry, Nanqiao is known as the "First Bridge in Tianfu."

Chengdu Ring Ecological Park

◆ The Chengdu Ring Ecological Park is located within 500 meters on either side of the Chengdu Ring Expressway in the central urban area and encompasses seven surrounding wedge-shaped plots. Spanning 12 districts, it encompasses 133 square kilometers of ecological land. It is a key link in the "Three Rings" of the Tianfu Greenway system, integrating ecological, leisure, and agricultural functions.

Guidelines in the Hotel (1)

- Upon arrival, please follow the tour leader's instructions and familiarise yourself with the location of the fire escape.

- The hotel provides basic toiletries. Please bring your own toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, shower gel, slippers, etc.
- Pay attention to the safe use of electrical facilities.
- Always pay attention to the location of emergency exits and escape directions.

- Please carry your valuables with you.
- Additional expenses, such as long-distance calls, drinks, luggage handling fees, and the "PAY" sign on the hotel TV, are at the student's own expense. Please pay by yourself when checking out.
- When using the restroom, please mind your steps to prevent slipping.
- Remember to take away all luggage and personal belongings before checking out. Lost properties cannot be retrieved.

Meal Arrangement

- The hotel provides a buffet breakfast. The main meal is served in a banquet style, usually in a restaurant. Halal food will be provided.
- The meals are nutritionally balanced and generously portioned, with local specialities incorporated in moderation.
- This tour is not an average gourmet or luxury tour.
- Cherish food and avoid wasting it.
- Due to food hygiene risks, students should not purchase takeaway food/drinks during their trip.

- Each table has approximately 10-12 people. Please take the seat assigned by the teacher.
- Any special dietary requirements, such as food allergies, should be declared before departure so the organisers can make arrangements.
- To ensure that public funds are well spent, meals and accommodation arrangements are based on "safety", "hygiene" and "simplicity".
 - Maintain a tidy environment at all times and respect the natural surroundings.
- Teachers will assess the health risks and, after consultation with the organiser, establish clear school-based requirements. Students must strictly follow school instructions.

Health guidelines

Before departure

- ► You must declare any health conditions (such as heart disease, asthma, etc.) and food allergies.
- ► Check your own temperature; those with a fever (≥37.5°C) should not travel.
- ► Consult your family doctor first if you have any medical concerns.

Maintain a balanced diet, get enough rest, avoid excessive stress, and pay attention to personal hygiene

physical discomfort

- Seek medical attention and follow the doctor's advice before deciding whether to continue.
- Notify teachers or the tour leader/guide immediately during the trip.
- Seek medical attention immediately and inform your doctor/school/the tour guide.

Suspected Infectious disease outbreak

Travel tips for health and hygiene

Food hygiene

- Patronize reliable and licensed restaurants.
- Ensure food is thoroughly cooked and avoid eating raw or undercooked seafood.
- Drink boiled water.
- Wash your hands before and after meals.

Mosquito-Borne Diseases

- Wear loose-fitting, light-colored, longsleeved tops and long pants.
- Stay in air-conditioned accommodations or areas with mosquito nets.
- Apply insect repellent containing DEET to exposed skin and clothing.

Preventing viral gastroenteritis

- Keep your hands clean at all times.
- Clean vomitus and faeces with gloves and a surgical mask, and wash your hands thoroughly afterwards.
- Avoid areas contaminated by vomitus or crowded places.

Animals or birds

- Avoid wet and live poultry markets or farms.
- Practice hand hygiene regularly.
- Eat thoroughly cooked eggs and poultry.
- If bitten by an animal, seek medical attention immediately and receive appropriate vaccinations.
- 1. In addition to DEET, other insect repellents with different active ingredients are available on the market, including IR3535 and icaridin (also known as Picaridin). When using insect repellents, be sure to follow the instructions and precautions on the product label.
- 2. Alcohol is not effective in killing norovirus, and alcohol-based hand sanitizers cannot replace hand washing with soap and water.



Red or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal / Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above:

- Pay close attention to weather forecasts /special reports from radio or television stations on the day of departure.
- If there is no cancellation notice, you must assemble on time even if a Gale or Storm Signal No. 8 or a Red or Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted. Pay attention to safety and prepare in advance.
- The tour leader or staff will maintain communication with the school. If a change or cancellation is decided, the teacher will notify the students.

Remarks: Please pay attention to the local weather report before departure.

- **□** Internet Options:
 - Hong Kong Prepaid Data SIM Card: The most reliable way to use WhatsApp (purchase before departure)
 - Mainland China Wi-Fi: Some require a mainland mobile phone number/WeChat account for verification, so reception may be unstable.
