HOMEWORK POLICY

Purposes

- 1. To consolidate classroom learning while preparing students for new learning; and facilitate selflearning with appropriate design and guidance
- 2. To enable teachers to identify students' learning problems and adjust the teaching plans and strategies accordingly, and provide timely feedback to students to enhance students' learning effectiveness
- 3. To enable parents to understand the requirements of the school Curriculum so that parents and schools can work together to help students make improvement in learning

Guidelines

- 1. Homework is an indispensable component in the learning and teaching process. There are clear targets and expected learning outcomes for homework.
- 2. The mode and content of homework cater for students' learning needs and ability so that students are supported to extend and consolidate their learning based on the existing knowledge.
- 3. All kinds of exercises which focus on mechanical drilling, repeated copying and rote learning are avoided.
- 4. Homework is not only confined to written assignments. It is varied in types in accordance with the needs of the students. Reading books, magazines and newspapers; searching information from various sources; listening to radio broadcasting; watching documentaries; acquiring knowledge in daily life are as important as written assignments.
- 5. Homework is designed in a way to:
 - a. keep pace with the teaching schedule in class and help students consolidate and develop concepts;
 - b. integrate interesting and motivating tasks while avoiding rote learning;
 - c. stimulate learning motivation, provoke thinking and active learning;
 - d. develop students' self-motivated learning and creativity;
 - e. cater for students' individual needs;
 - f. offer a challenge to students; and
 - g. develop good reading habits.
- 6. Timely feedback from teachers enhances learning effectiveness.
- 7. Approximate time for students to finish their homework per day:

Level	Time
P.1 & P.2	approx. 45-60 minutes
P.3 & P.4	approx. 60-75 minutes
P.5 & P.6	approx. 75-90 minutes
