**Chinese Summer Bridging Programme**

Lots will be drawn to allocate places if the number of applications received exceeds the limit.</li> <li>2. <b>Full attendance throughout the programme is expected and considered essential.</b> Students must attend at least 80% of all sessions to qualify for a certificate of participation. Parents will also receive a certificate for participating in the parent-child activity.</li> <li>3. Students should bring their own lunch and wear the proper school uniform or PE uniform as specified in the timetable to be issued later.</li> <li>4. <b>No school bus service will be provided.</b></li> <li>5. The Chinese Summer Bridging Programme will be suspended in the event of adverse weather conditions if the Education Bureau announces a corresponding class suspension on that day. <b>A make-up class will be arranged on 28 July 2026 (Tue).</b></li> </ol>
