Assessment and Examination Arrangements for 2025-2026 Academic Year

Please be advised of the assessment and examination arrangements for the 2025–2026 academic year. The school integrates formative assessments—ongoing evaluations designed to inform and enhance the learning process—and summative assessments, which serve to evaluate overall student achievement to foster student growth and development.

A. Assessment Arrangement (Primary 1 only)

To facilitate a smooth transition from kindergarten to primary education, the school will not administer written examinations for Primary 1 students during the first term. Commencing in the second term, Primary 1 students will engage in formative assessments. Furthermore, Primary 1 students will undertake the Final Examination in June 2026, which will contribute to their overall annual results. Prior to the examination, teachers evaluate students' performance through classwork, homework assignments, quizzes, projects, and participation in class activities.

- ❖ Fitness Test: *Conducted two weeks before examination weeks
 - *Include four items: 1min. Sit-ups, Sit & Reach, Hand Grip, 6 mins. Run/Walk (P.1-P.3) and 9mins. Run/Walk (P.4-P.6)
- ❖ Attitude: *Assessed based on sportsmanship, teamwork, participation and fair play.

Scores are determined in accordance with the secondary school admission model, which allocates weightings as follows: Chinese, English, and Mathematics are weighted at 9; General Studies at 6; Visual Arts at 3; and Music at 2.

D) Class Placement

- ❖ It is based on overall performance in English, Mathematics, and General Studies/Primary Humanities/Primary Science, plus the conduct grade.
- Class A: Students with excellent academic grades and good conduct grade*
- o Classes B, C, D: Even distribution of remaining students.
- o Chinese Elite and C1 Class: For students excelling in Chinese.
- o Chinese C2, C3 Classes: Even distribution of remaining students.
- o Chinese CR Class: For students who need support in Chinese.
- o Maths R Class: For P.4-P.6 students who need support in Maths.
- * Students will not be placed in Class A if:
 - i. any student has received either a yellow or red caution card; or if
 - ii. they have been assigned a B- or lower for their conduct grade on two or more occasions in their report cards.
