Be Vigilant Against Chikungunya Fever

We would like to draw your attention to the ongoing Chikungunya fever (CF) outbreaks reported in multiple regions worldwide, as well as in neighbouring regions of Hong Kong, including Guangdong Province. We urge you to remain vigilant against the disease.

CF is transmitted to humans through the bites of infective mosquitoes. Patients may experience fever and debilitating joint pain. Other common signs and symptoms include muscle pain, headache, nausea, fatigue and rash. Symptoms usually last for a few days, while in some cases joint pain may persist for months. Occasionally, CF can result in severe complications of the eye, heart and nerves.

Let us help to prevent CF by taking part in mosquito control actions such as avoiding the accumulation of stagnant water and eliminating mosquito breeding sites. We should also adopt personal protective measures against mosquito bites. Wear light-coloured long-sleeved clothes and trousers and apply insect repellent containing DEET to clothing or uncovered areas of the body when doing outdoor activities. Suspected cases should seek medical advice promptly and provide travel details to the doctor.
