Students should arrive at LCU at the usual time of 9:00 a.m. to attend the morning lessons of the Chinese Summer Bridging Programme. 3. Round-trip transportation between LCU and the venue will be provided. 4. Students should wear school PE uniform. 5. Students and parents may be allocated to attend the visit on another day if the number of applications for a particular day exceeds the maximum limit. Otherwise, a ballot will be conducted. 6. Applicants will be notified of the application result on or before 4 July 2026 (Saturday). If you are unable to join the visit due to unforeseen circumstances after signing the notice, please inform the school as soon as possible so that the vacancy can be filled. 7. If Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or above is hoisted on the day of the visit, or if a Red or Black Rainstorm Warning is in force before 9:30 a.m., the Museum will be closed until the warning is cancelled. The visit may be rescheduled depending on availability. Parents will be informed of the arrangements at a later time.
