**Contingency Measures of School due to a Confirmed Case of  
Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)**

Please note the following:

1. School Closure

The school has received information from The Centre for Health Protection (CHP) that one of our students is a confirmed case of COVID-19. He is now being quarantined. As advised by CHP, **our school has to be closed from 19-1-2022 (Wednesday) to 31-1-2022 (Monday). Students and parents should not come to school.** School will arrange a small number of staff to handle school affairs and answer phone calls during the aforesaid period. Our school has strengthened the cleansing and disinfection of the school premises. School will open on 4-2-2022 (Fri).

2. Arrangements of Real-time Zoom Lessons

**All students have to attend real-time Zoom lessons at home.** However, due to unforeseeable situations such as technical problems or health conditions of teachers, students of classes in the same level may have to combine to attend the lessons. In such case, the class teachers concerned will let the students know during the class period that morning. Please accommodate the inconvenience caused.

3. Compulsory Testing

In accordance with the CHP Regulation, **all personnel including our students staying at the school premises for more than one hour from 10-1-2022 (Mon) to 14-1-2022 (Fri) are required to undergo 4 Compulsory Testings** on 18-1-2022 (Tue), 21-1-2022 (Fri), 26-1-2022 (Wed) and 2-2-2022 (Wed) respectively at the community testing centres <https://www.communitytest.gov.hk/en/>.

**Failure to comply with the compulsory testing order is an offence** and the offender may be liable to a fine of \$25,000 and imprisonment for six months.

If a student is tested preliminarily positive or a confirmed case of COVID-19, parents must inform the school immediately.

4. Postponement of Purchasing Exercise Books and Visual Arts Materials

Purchase of the above items which is scheduled on 21-1-2022 (Fri) has to be postponed. You will be informed of the rescheduled date in due course.

5. Advice for Parents

Our school would like to urge parents to stay vigilant and put in place appropriate preventive measures to guard against the spread of COVID-19, based on the health advice from CHP. For details, please refer to <https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/eng/health-advice.html>.
