**Suspension of Zoom Lessons for facilitation of
Compulsory Testings on 21 and 26 Jan 2022**

Please note the following:

1. School Closure

The school received information from The Centre for Health Protection (CHP) that one of our students is a confirmed case of COVID-19 on 18-1-2022. He is now being quarantined. To facilitate all staff to complete the compulsory testing on time, there will be **no staff on duty** at school on **21-1-2022 and 26-1-2022**. **Parents and students should not come to school.**

2. Arrangements and Suspension of Real-time Zoom Lessons on 21 and 26 Jan

All students have to **attend real-time Zoom lessons at home**. However, due to unforeseeable situations such as technical problems or health conditions of teachers, students of classes in the same level may have to combine to attend the lessons. In such case, the class teachers concerned will let the students know during the class period that morning. Please accommodate the inconvenience caused.

As all teachers have to undergo the compulsory testing, there will be **no Zoom lessons on 21-1-2022 (Fri) and 26-1-2022 (Wed)**.

3. Compulsory Testing

In accordance with the CHP Regulation, **all personnel including our students and parents staying at the school premises for more than one hour from 28-12-2021 (Tue) to 14-1-2022 (Fri) are required to undergo 4 Compulsory Testings** on 18/19-1-2022, 21-1-2022 (Fri), 26-1-2022 (Wed) and 2-2-2022 (Wed) respectively at the community testing centres <https://www.communitytest.gov.hk/en/station/>.

Failure to comply with the compulsory testing order is an offence and the offender may be liable to a fine of \$25,000 and imprisonment for six months.

If a student or parent is tested preliminarily positive or a confirmed case of COVID-19, parents must inform the school immediately.

4. Advice for Parents

Our school would like to urge parents to stay vigilant and put in place appropriate preventive measures to guard against the spread of COVID-19, based on the health advice from CHP. For details, please refer to <https://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/eng/health-advice.html>.

Our school will keep close contact with CHP and closely monitor the health conditions of our staff and students.
