Brief description of feedback and follow up from the evaluation of last Annual School Plan:

- Students could generalize and apply different learning strategies and study skills in all subjects and use them effectively to benefit learning.
- More online platforms or multi-media resources for e-learning would be purchased for different KLAs so as to enhance students' self-learning ability and cater for learner's diversity.
- Age-appropriate STEAM project learning will be continued with adjustment in the coming academic year. Students will be arranged to join more STEAM-related local or international activities or competitions so as to broaden students' exposure to STEAM and apply the skills in different contexts.
- Reading workshops or talks for parents and students will be continued to further enhance the reading culture both at home and in LCU. They will be arranged in the first term to help parents and students develop the reading skills earlier.
- Chinese subject teachers will join P.5 Chinese School-based Support Program organized by EDB to discuss effective strategies for teaching writing. The dissemination of good teaching practices will undoubtedly benefit LCU.
- Teachers will be nominated to join STEAM-related programmes and workshops on other relevant themes so that more teachers will be confident in implementing CoolThink@JC and running STEAM activities inside and outside classrooms.
